Overview

Green Economy and Sustainability is a master's degree entirely taught in English forming graduates who are qualified to assume **managerial or consultant positions in the Green Economy sector**.

The course provides students with inter-disciplinary abilities in order to enable them to address issues related to green economy and sustainable development.

The main topics of *Green economy and sustainability* are *eco-innovation, green economy and sustainable development*.

Challenging eco-policy issues - from both national and international perspectives - are studied as well.
