Largest urban air monitoring program in the U.S.

The Commoner Center at Queens College, City University of New York, in collaboration with the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene has designed and implemented the ongoing New York City Community Air Survey (NYCCAS). This network, one of the largest urban air monitoring networks in the world, has measured major air pollutants at 60 to 155 sites throughout the city from 2008 to the present. Results of this research have advanced knowledge and have been utilized by policy-makers and the public to better understand geographic and time trends in air pollution city-wide.
