The proposed research project is not binding with regard to the subsequent topic that will be carried out during the three year course.	Up to 16 points
Statement of research interest	Short text – max. length: 300 types – in English or in Italian, which must present the candidate's motivations in choosing the Ph.D. Course and the description of his/her research interests.	Up to 4 points
