Founded in **1391**, the University of Ferrara stands among the most ancient academic institutions in the world.

Located in the medieval city of Ferrara, the University has always played an influential role over the urban social context.

In **1797** it became the first European university with a course in constitutional law.

Nicholas Copernicus took his degree at Unife and **Paracelsus** studied here.
