

Registration for Quantitative Methods exam

When you register to take the Quantitative Methods (QM) exam via the website studiare.unife.it, you have to sign up both for the exam regarding the Mathematical Module (MM) and for the exam regarding the Statistical Module (SM) and at the same time for the global exam QM. You can very easily identify MM, SM and QM exams, because they are respectively characterized by the entries Ghiselli-Ragni, Bonnini and Ghiselli-Ragni-Bonnini in the field “Descrizione Appello”.

Please, remark that every session consists of two examinations, hereafter called first and second according to the chronological order, and that the three above-mentioned registrations (MM, SM and QM) must refer to the same exam, either the first or the second one.

Example: Winter session 2016.

MM exam dates: Jan 13 and Feb 12.

SM exam dates: Jan 11 and Jan 26.

QM exam dates: Jan 13 and Feb 12.

If you want to sign up for the first exam, you must choose MM on date Jan 13, SM on date Jan 11 and QM on date Jan 13 (the last one is only for the transcription of the final grade).

If you do not strictly follow this rule for registering, you cannot take MM exam nor SM exam.

You can read date, hour and room of every module exam in the field “Data ora aula”

Rules for assigning grades

Let m, n be the grades of MM and SM exam, respectively, with

$$m, n \in \{0, 18, 19, \dots, 31\},$$

where zero means that you have not passed the exam, while 31 corresponds to 30 cum laude.

Then, you pass the global QM exam **if and only if** $\min\{m, n\} \geq 18$: in this case, the final grade is given by $(m + n)/2$.

Please, remark that even if $\min\{m, n\} < 18$ and $\max\{m, n\} \geq 18$, in order to pass the global QM exam, you absolutely must take both MM and SM exams again.
