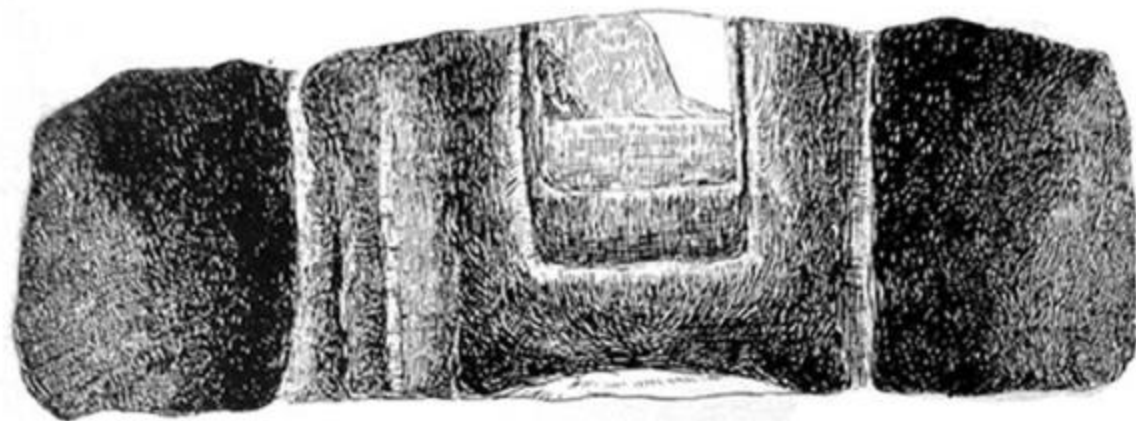

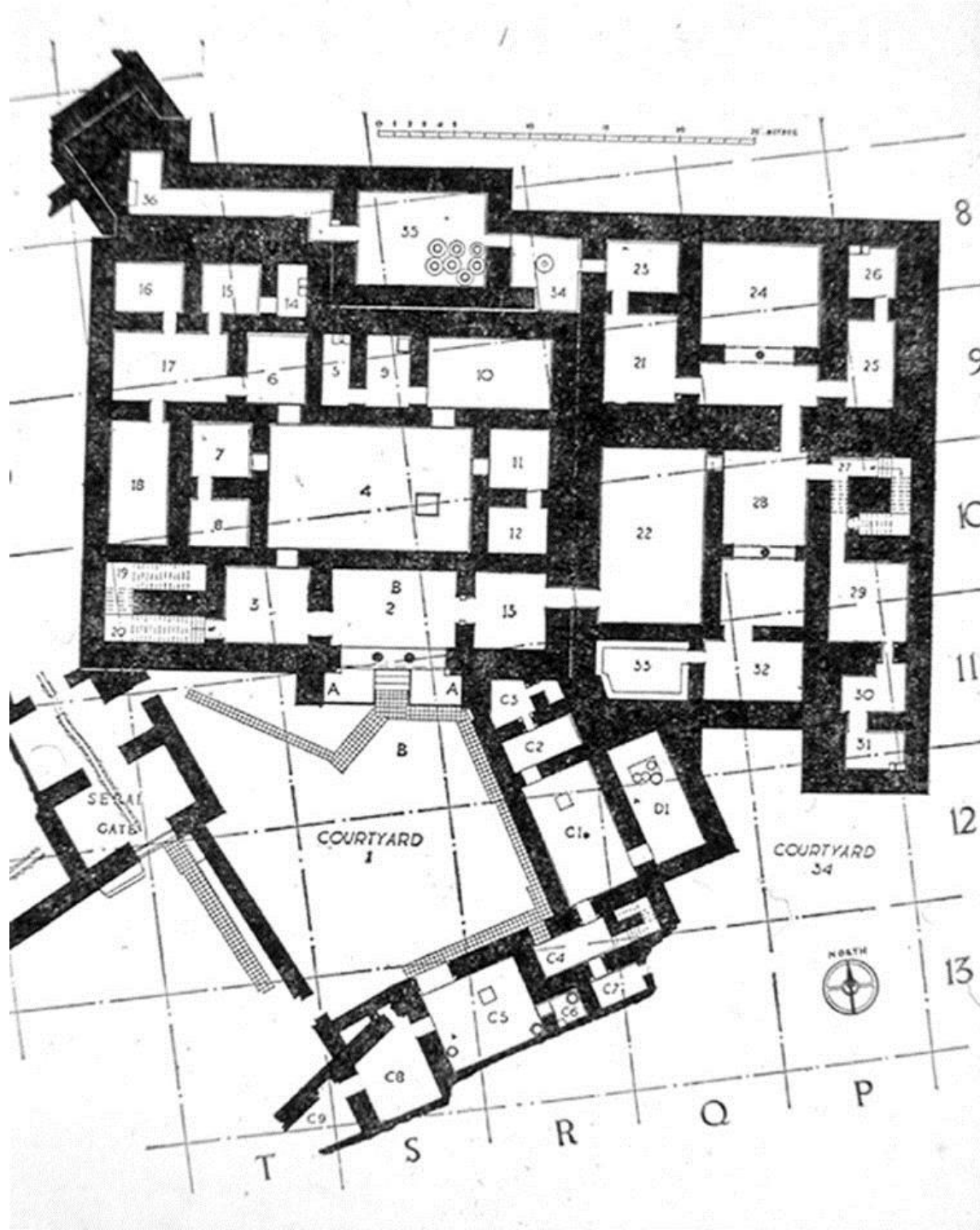

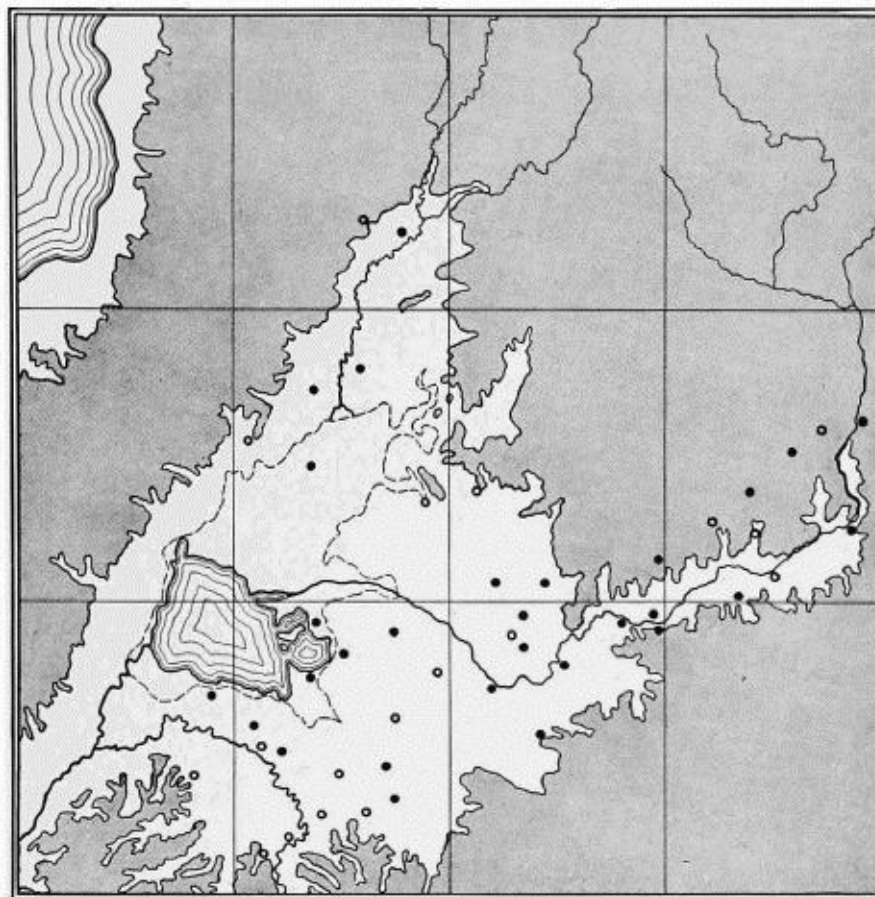
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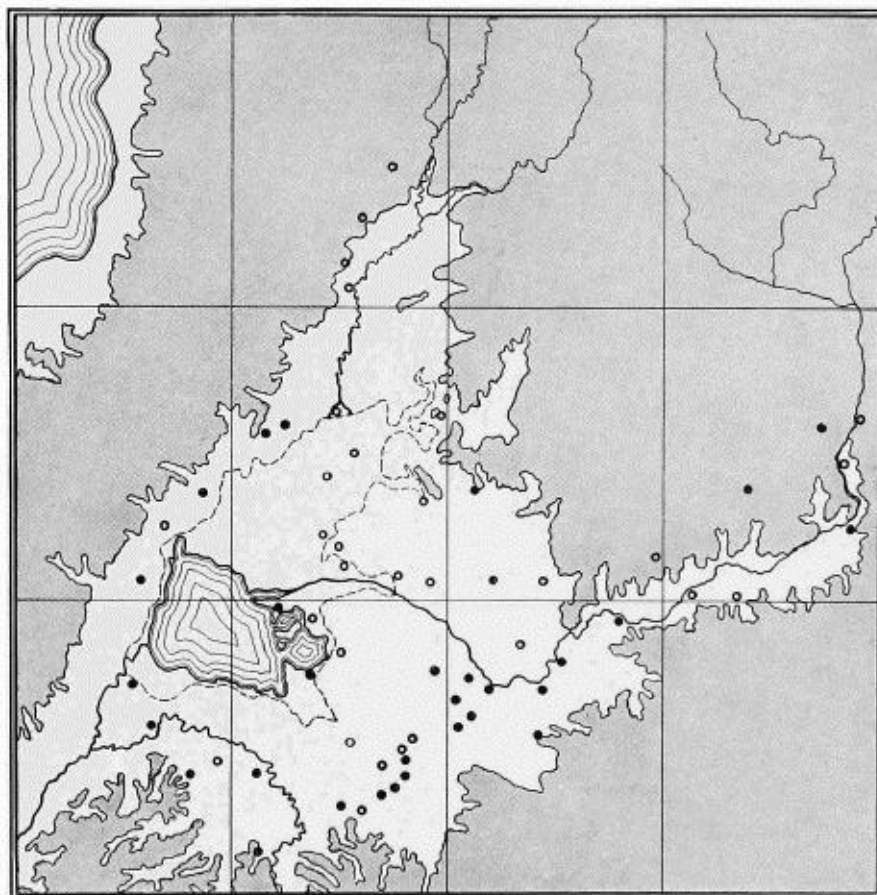
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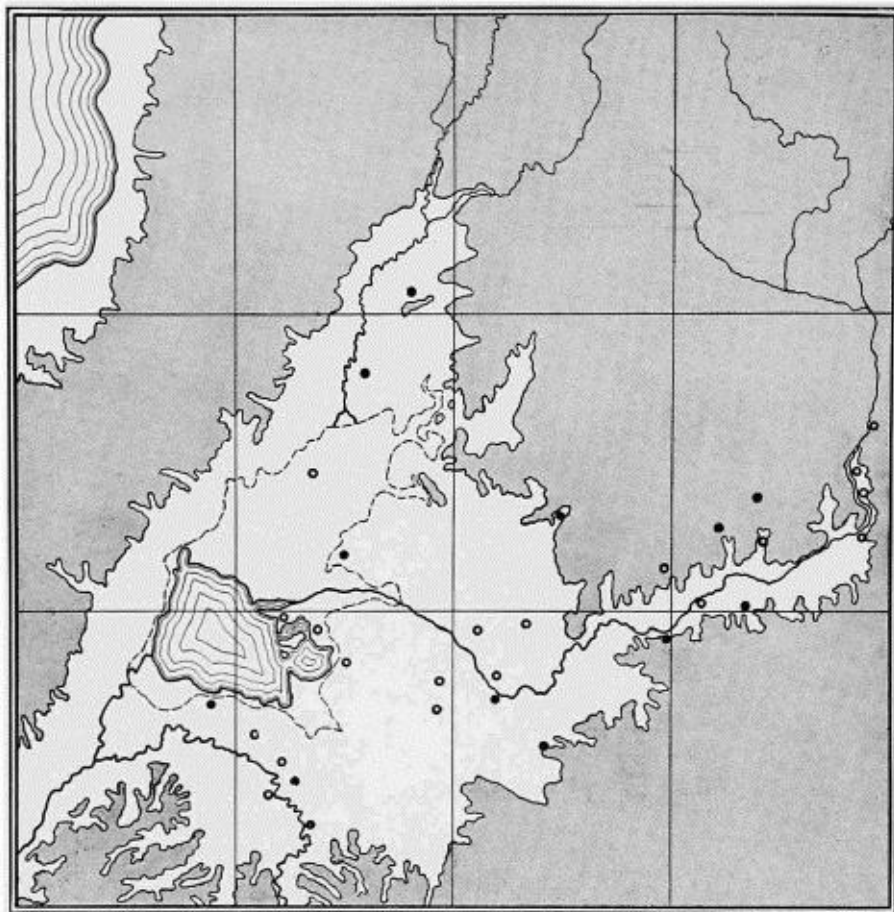
MAP XVI.—DISTRIBUTION OF JUDAIDAH V WARES

There seems to have been a fairly heavy occupation of the plain by the Period V people. The culture seems evenly distributed over the area, except west of the lake, and is especially well represented up the ʿAfrīn valley.



MAP XVIII.—DISTRIBUTION OF JUDAIAH VII WARES

Period VII was evidently one of the most flourishing in the history of the plain. Its traces are evenly distributed over the whole plain and up the river valleys, although its extension up the Kara Su is questionable. It is especially prevalent in that part of the plain between the Orontes and the Afrin.



MAP XVII.—DISTRIBUTION OF JUDAIAH VI WARES

During Period VI the occupation was evidently not very heavy, and none at all appears west of the lake or the Orontes. The certain sites up the ḥAfrīn valley are, in fact, more numerous in proportion to the area concerned than those in the plain.

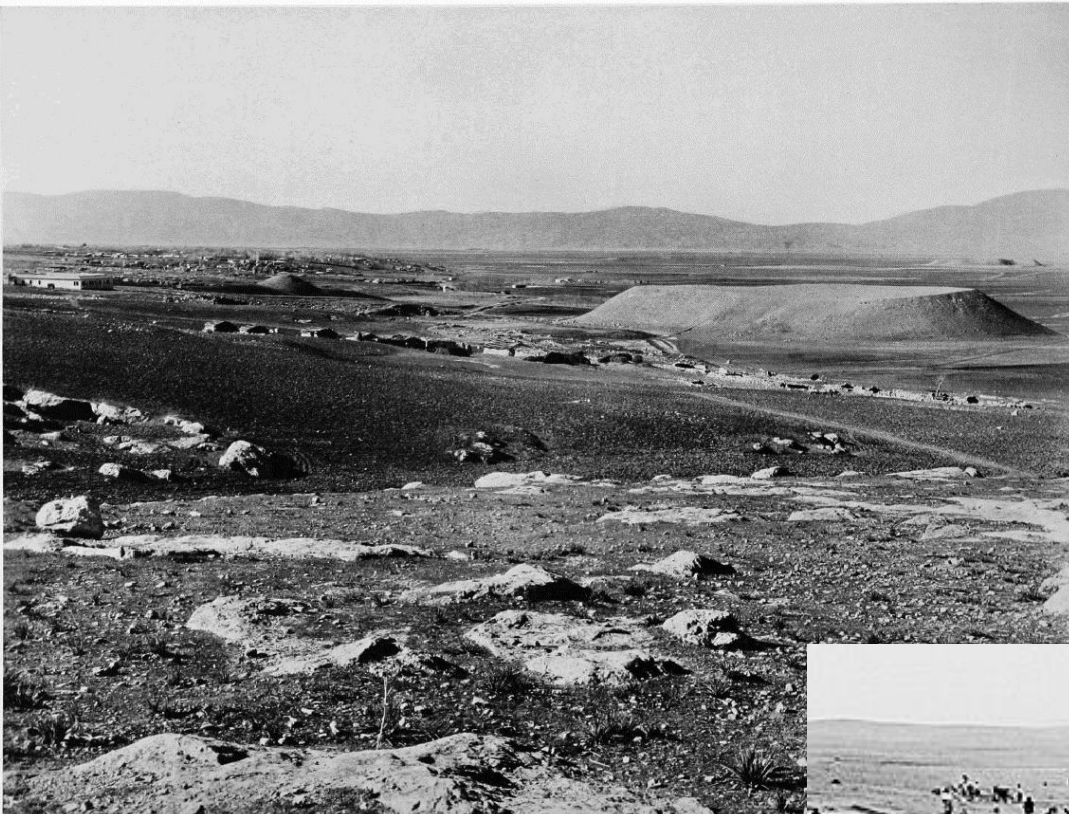


FIG. 2.—VIEW ACROSS THE PLAIN, WITH TELL AL-JUDAIDAH (No. 176) AT RIGHT AND TELL DHAHAB (N

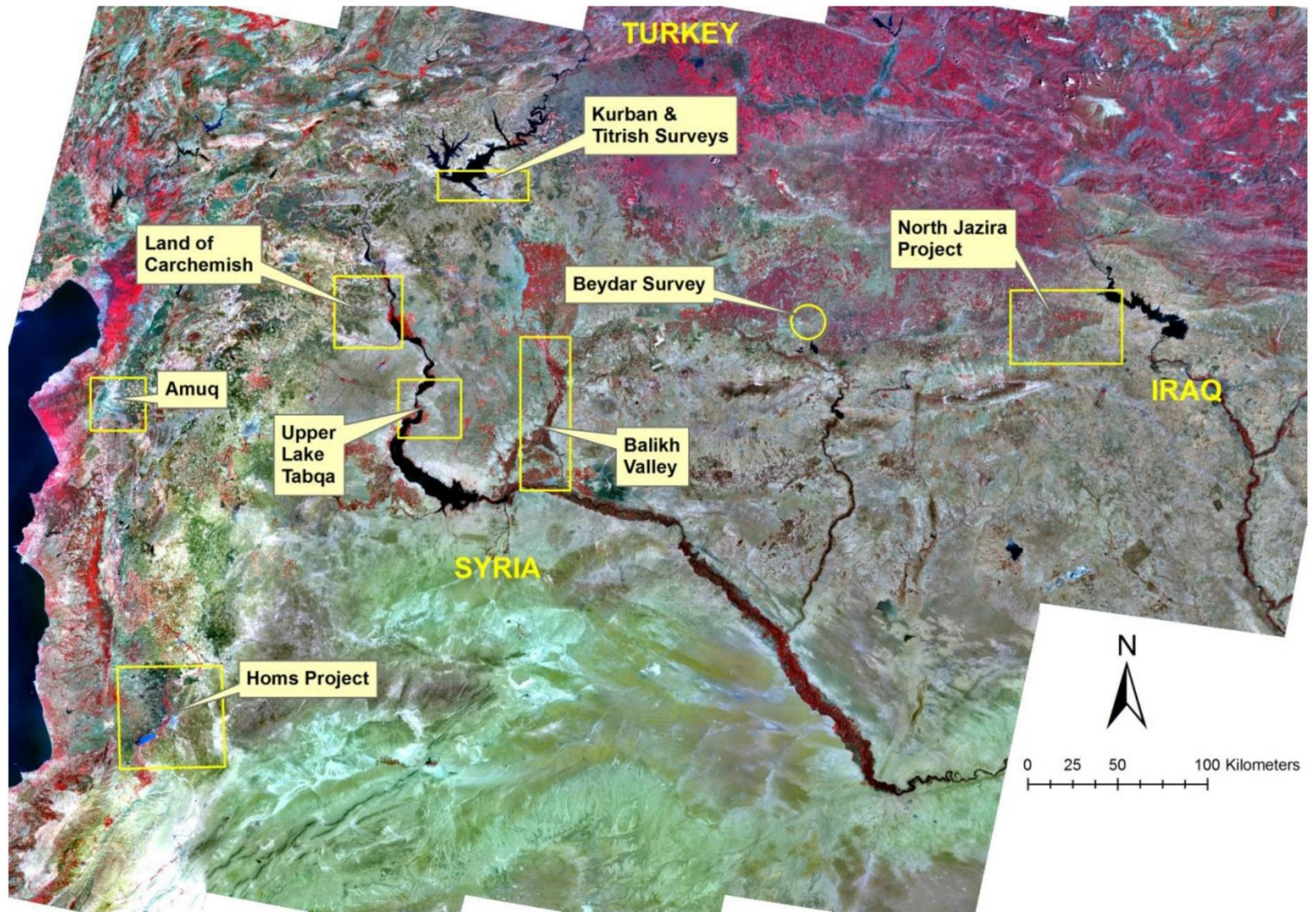
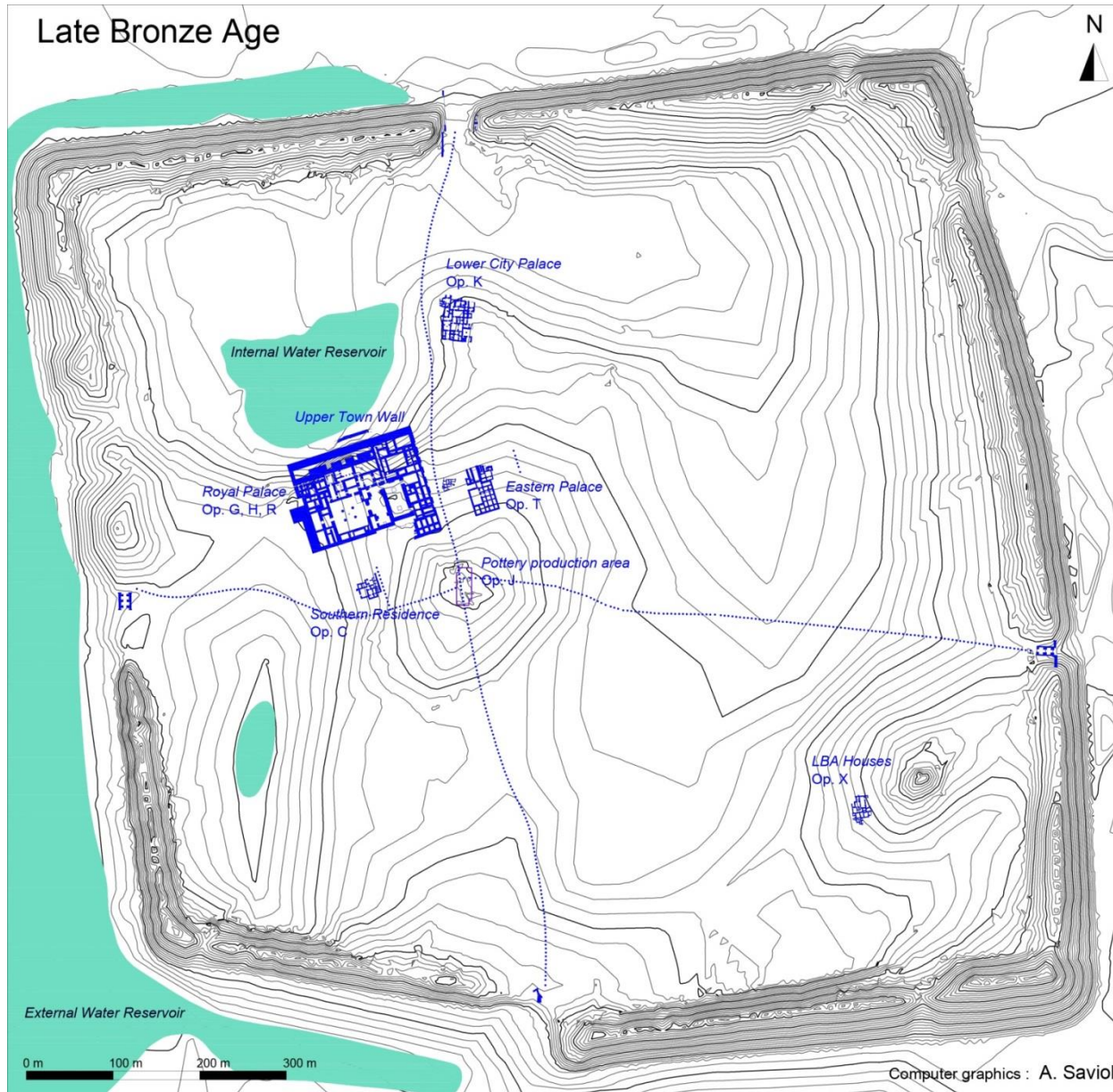


Figure 2. Sample survey areas (background: Landsat 4,3,2)
