	- before <b>June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2013</b> for students coming in the 1 <sup>st</sup> semester or full academic year;
	- before <b>November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2013</b> for students coming in the 2nd semester
Registration	The academic year at the Nancy School of Architecture usually starts on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of September and ends on June 30 <sup>th</sup> . The 1 <sup>st</sup> semester starts on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of September and ends on January 31 <sup>st</sup> The second semester starts on the 1 <sup>st</sup> week of February and ends on June 30 <sup>th</sup> .
	The School advises the students to come around the 7 <sup>th</sup> of September / January in order to go to the International Relations Office and to complete the registration process.
	In order to be enrolled at Nancy School of Architecture, incoming students are asked to bring in : 2 passports size pictures, copy of their student card from the sending institution, European health insurance card, legal liability certificate.
	The examinations are usually held in winter (January and February), summer (June and July) and autumn (September and October).
