<u>Courses selection</u>: Students are asked to choose a major field of study but will be free to take courses in other fields. The access to courses in professional licence, musical licence and 2nd year of Master, is not guaranteed. Students will need to contact the relevant head teacher prior to arrival, to be authorised to attend such courses.
