Visa Requirements	All students who wish to take up temporary residence in Liechtenstein for the purpose of study need to apply for a short- term residence permit. Residence permits are issued by the Immigration and Passport Office. All students will receive the application form from our staff responsible for visa and residence permits. All students residing outside of EU/EEA states or Switzerland require a Schengen visa for entry to Liechtenstein. They need to get in contact with the nearest Swiss Embassy in their country.
