Application deadlines	For Winter semester :30th June/ for Summer semester:15th December	
Documents required for application	Students who are interested in studying at the Silesian University of Technology as Erasmus exchange students are advised to contact their home university coordinator or International Mobility Office to find out whether a bilateral agreement has been concluded between the two universities, and if so – whether the required programme of studies shall be approved.	
	International Mobility Office of the Silesian University of Technology should receive <b>NOMINATION</b> <b>LETTER</b> by e-mail from Relations Office of the student's home university firstly, before any application is sent.	
	Nomination letter should contain following data: - student's full name and surname, - gender,	
	<ul> <li>valid e-mail address,</li> <li>receiving faculty at the Silesian University of Technology,</li> <li>period of stay (winter/summer semester, whole academic year).</li> <li>field, kind and cyrcle of studies</li> </ul>	
	When the nomination is pre-accepted, following documents will be required by SUT's International Mobilty Office.:	
	<ul> <li>Student Application Form;</li> <li>Learning Agreement – student should collect 25-30 ECTS credits per semester;</li> <li>Accommodation Form;</li> <li>Transcript of Records;</li> <li>Language proficiency document which confirms English skills and proper level to know you'll be able to follow lectures and pass exams.</li> </ul>

English Language Requirements	<ul> <li>TOEFL test with a score of at least 550 for Bachelor and Master studies,</li> <li>IELTS test with a score of at least 6.0 for Bachelor and Master studies,</li> <li>FCE test with grade B for Bachelor and Master studies.</li> <li>or other certificate issued by Foreign Language Center of student's home University</li> </ul>	
	Students who graduated from an English - speaking high school and have proved it, are not required to submit any additional documents to prove their English language proficiency

Expenses	The cost of living in Gliwice is 300€ per month without accommodation. Students have access to canteens at the University Campus. Lunch at the university canteen costs about 3-4 €. Breakfasts and dinners are not offered.		
Health insurance requirements	<ul> <li>Students from the EU/EEA countries staying temporarily in the territory of Poland are entitled to free health care on the basis of the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or in particular cases on the basis of a special certificate (translated into Polish by sworn translator).</li> <li>You shouldn't forget about insurance against accidents (EHIC is just a health insurance).</li> <li>Students from non-EU/EEA countries should buy their health accidents insurance and third party liability insurance at their home country, before arrival. In case of the ISIC or Euro&lt;26 card, insurance is included in the card and it is not necessary to buy another one unless one wants to increase its scope or value. According to the state health regulations, foreigners have to pay for medical consultation.
