APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The students who wish to come and study in Ovidius University of Constanta in the frame of the Erasmus Program can send their applications in the period:

- **15th of March 15th of Jun,** for the first semester and the whole academic year;
- 15th of July 15th of November, for the second semester.

The University has to send an e-mail to <u>socrates@univ-ovidius.ro</u> or a fax to **+40 241 606 499**, announcing the names of the selected students and containing the following data: **name**, **faculty**, **level** (undergraduate, postgraduate, doctorate), **period of the mobility** (first semester, second semester or the whole academic year) and **e-mail address** for each student that has been selected to come and study at Ovidius University.

Then, each student has to fill and send by e-mail/fax and by ordinary mail a copy of the following documents:

- Application form;
- Accommodation form;
- Learning agreement.

The application form has to be sent along with the transcript of records, CV, English or Romanian Language certificate, a copy of Passport and/or National ID card of the student.

In order to fill in the learning agreement, each student can search on our website (<u>www.univ-ovidius.ro</u>) for the list of courses and if they don't manage to find the list of disciplines taught in the faculty he is interested in, he can write an e-mail to <u>socrates@univ-ovidius.ro</u> with the subject: learning agreement and it has to contain the **name**, **home university**, **faculty**, **level and period of the mobility**.

Almost all of the courses are held in Romanian language. BA Programs available in foreign languages:

- Letters, Cultural Studies: 3 years English
- Language and Literature: 3 years English/French
- Mathematics and Informatics: 3 years English

- Medical School: 3 years in English+3 Years in Romanian. Master studies:

- Anglo-American Studies in English

- French linguistics and didactic studies in French

Courses start on the 1st of October.

Each year is divided into two semesters. Each semester lasts fourteen weeks or fifteen weeks for medicine. Students have a Christmas and Easter holiday, a holiday at the end of the first semester and a summer holiday.

Examination takes place at the end of each semester. They may be oral or written. A reexamination period is scheduled before the beginning of the new academic year. Classes are held from Monday to Saturday.
