## Required Documents for Application

<u>For Non-European students staying for the **Full academic Year**: You will have to subscribe to the French Health insurance upon arrival in Dijon (information will be given during the induction week)</u>

- 4. Curriculum vitae / résumé in French or English
- 5. Copy of birth certificate (only for non-European students staying for the full academic year)
- 6. A certified copy of your degree translated into French or English (only for students who have obtained a degree)
- 7. Proof of command of the English language for students wishing to study in English (only for non-English native students): IELTS 6.0 or TOEIC 750 or IBT TOEFL 80
- 8. Proof of command of the French language for students wishing to study in French (only for non-French native students): TCF 4

Induction week	A <b>COMPULSORY</b> induction week is organized before the beginning of classes in order to help students to settle into Dijon: administrative workshops and help concerning visa, health insurance, accommodation matters and opening a bank account.  Social events will be organized by the association for international students, "Melting Potes"		
Pick-up Service	All students must fill in their arrival information on our website at the following link:  www.bsbu.eu/international/practical-informations/pick-up-service-and-induction-week/  The form is available from June for the Autumn and from December for the Spring  A free pick-up service from Dijon train station will be provided on specific dates.		
Accommodation	BSB does not have its own residence. However, the International Office can help you to find the best option either in residences or homestays. Accommodation options and prices are listed on our website. Accommodation Expenses	Generally from € 350 to € 550 per month		
Insurance Policy	It is compulsory for all students living in France to subscribe to:  - Personal liability insurance "responsabilité civile"  - Insurance policy for your accommodation covering at least water damage and fire.  You can take out insurance cover (which usually includes both liability insurance and insurance policy) with the company of your choice or a French bank when opening a bank account.		
Housing Benefit	Exchange students can apply for housing benefit from the French government (Caisse d'Allocations Familiales, CAF) under certain conditions (to be confirmed during the induction week as they are subject to change). All students are required to have health insurance from their home country covering medical repatriation for the full semester or the full year.

<u>European students (under 28 years old)</u>: will have to bring their European Health Insurance card and will be then exempted from registering for French social security.

Non-European students (under 28 years old) staying 1 semester only: will be exempted from registering for French health insurance provided that they show an International Health insurance certificate from their home country

Non-European students (under 28 years old) staying for the full year: Even if they have private health insurance, they will be required to register for French health insurance (213 Euros for the 2014/2015 academic year). The application form will be provided upon arrival by the International office.

<u>European and non-European students over 28 years old:</u> Are not entitled to French student insurance and will have to be covered by an international health insurance or private insurance.

- Visa (compulsory for all Non European students): Once in Dijon, a fee of 58 €
   (2014 amount) will be required for the validation of your long-term student visa.
- Health insurance: Non European Economic Area citizens under 28 years of age by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 and staying for the full academic year will have to pay the annual fee of €215 for the French Social Security (compulsory health insurance).
