Description of activities the student will be involved in	Getting involved, the trainee will acquire skills and knowledge in Mediterranean gardening, dealing with harsh dry periods in summertime and sometimes excessive rainy periods in wintertime. Information about the native Cretan flora, natural habitats of Crete, threatened and rare endemics, local ethno botany of medicinal and aromatic plants, food plants, and others, as wild species, as well as information about traditionally cultivated species on the island of Crete: old varieties of fruits and vegetables, citruses, vine varieties, olives, will be acquired during practicing. Working in decorative gardening, the trainees will get to know which species are suitable under the climatic conditions of Crete, which are the positive or negative impacts by introducing alien species, benefits of using local species, etc. Re vegetation of the gardens gives opportunity to get involved in environmental landscaping, by taking in consideration the natural habitats of the island of Crete and by reconstruction of such environments, consequently giving life space to various species of the local flora and fauna.
