<i>Departement/Function:</i>	Production and Coordination. To help with implementing all of Paso a 2`s projects. We have several new ones this year and there will be plenty of work, including helping to organize a new facet of fundraising.
<i>Description of activities:</i>	Some administration, helping to organize budgets and produce the activities we organize throughout the year. We are a very small organization so there is plenty of hands-on experience available. Depending on the profile of the person who comes to work with us, we can adapt responsibilities to try to include the areas that they are most interested in.
<i>Duration/ starting date:</i>	Can be flexible. The Certamen pre-selection process starts in September and the Certamen is held in December, but since we have other activities throughout the year, there are projects happening in May-June, plus all of the preparation for the Certamen which has been going on since Dec. 19 th , when we finished the last activities for the 26° CCM, in 2012.
