FORMAL ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

Young people and adults resident or domiciled in the Emilia-Romagna region on a date prior to registration for the activities regardless of their employment status and therefore including students. For those enrolled in AFAM universities/institutes based in the region, residence/domicile is not relevant.

SUBSTANTIAL REQUIREMENTS

People coming from different study paths and/or work experiences, with particular but not exclusive reference to economics, engineering, chemistry.

Considering that some teaching will be carried out by international experts, to attend the course a good knowledge of the English language (level B2) will be required.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Analysis of the curriculum vitae;
- Analysis of the cover letter;
- Possible interview aimed at verifying the consistency of the candidate's profile with the path, expectations and motivation to participate in the course as well as the level of knowledge of the English language.

The interview may also be carried out remotely via video conference.

Following the assessment session, a ranking will be drawn up and the first 14 candidates for each edition will be able to access the path. In the event of a tie, priority will be given to the youngest student.

It will be possible to consider extending the number of participants up to 20 in the case of valid applications.
