Indipendentemente da ciò, tuttavia, in un caso come questo il *pre-refrain* è divenuto un vero e proprio *pre-chorus*, e ha acquistato lo *status* di componente formale autonoma: può infatti presentarsi anche svincolato dal *chorus*, come avviene qui dopo il primo *verse*].
