




FIG. 2. Pelle tesa sul telaio.






FIG. 52. Ricapitolazione degli elementi della rigatura (dal *Vocabulaire codicologique* 1985). Z. Foro di costruzione; X. Foratura per squadratura; Y. Foro di guida; Su, TV. Giustificazione; STUV. Squadratura; ST. Riga di testa; UV. Riga di piede; C-D-E. Intercolunnio; P-Q. Intercolunnio volante; K-L. Righe serrate, riga doppia; H, K, L, M, N. Marginale; U, V. riga di margine; W, Y. Squadratura esterna; A-B. Colonnina;
