Word			Definition	Translation
assessment (n)			the process in which a nurse makes a judgement about a person's health	
bleed (v)			to lose blood because of an injury	
cubicle (n)			a small separate area in a room	
date of birth (DOB) (n)			the day, month and year you were born on	
doctor (n)			someone who is trained to treat people who are ill [= <i>Dr. written abbreviation</i>]	
fill in (phr v)			to write all the necessary information on an official document, form, etc.	
hospital (n)			a building where sick or injured people receive medical treatment	
patient (n)			someone who is getting medical treatment from a doctor or in hospital	
priority (v)			the thing that you think is most important and that needs your attention first	
treat (v)			to give someone medical treatment for an illness or injury	
waiting room (n)			a room for people to wait in, for example, to see a doctor
