administer (v)			to give someone a drug or medical treatment	
charge nurse (n)			a nurse who is responsible for the work done in a particular part of a hospital	
cleaner (n)			someone whose job is to clean buildings, houses, etc.	
consultant (n)			<i>British English</i> a doctor at a hospital who knows a lot about a particular area of medicine	
deal with (phr v)			to take action in order to solve a problem or make sure that something is done properly	
diabetes (n)			a disease in which the body cannot control the amount of sugar in the blood	
operation (n)			when doctors cut into someone's body to repair or remove a part that is damaged	
paramedic (n)			someone who usually works in an ambulance and is trained to help ill or injured people, but is not a doctor or nurse	
porter (n)			<i>British English</i> someone who transports patients around a hospital	
receptionist (n)			someone whose job is to welcome and deal with people arriving at a hospital	
responsible (adj)			if you are responsible for something, you are in charge of it or it is your job to do it	
scrub nurse (n)			a nurse who is responsible for looking after patients during surgery and after their operations	
specialise (v)			to study mainly one subject or do mainly one activity	
triage (n)			deciding who receives medical treatment first in based on how serious an injury is	
urgent (adj)			sth that is urgent is very important and needs to be dealt with immediately
