<b>Curriculum studiorum</b>	<b>Mandatory documents:</b> Complete academic career (Bachelor, Masters degrees) information with certifications or self-declarations with a list of examinations and grades and final marks, for Bachelor and Masters degrees; Abstract of the Master Degree thesis (max length 12.000 character spaces included), with the following structure: motivations, research methodology and results obtained or expected, essential bibliography. Only for undergraduates students: the abstract must be signed by the supervisor.	Up to 8 points
<b>Research Project</b>	Maximum length: 18.000 types (spaces included), in English or in Italian which must contain an original proposal for a research project, with the following structure: introduction to the scientific international context, relevance of the topic, expected results, argumentation. The proposed research project is not binding with regard to the subsequent topic that will be carried out during the three year course.	Up to 33 points
<b>Scientific publications</b>	<b>Mandatory documents:</b> Full text of the publications, including abstracts or papers presented to meetings or congresses <b>OR</b> Document with the complete list of publications, with the connected links.	Up to 3 points
<b>Statement of Research Interest</b>	Short text - maximum length: 6.000 types - in English or in Italian, containing the candidate’s motivations to attend the Ph.D. programme and the specific research interests.	Up to 3 points

<b>Other Academic or Professional qualifications</b>	International linguistic certificates; certified working experiences in the field; Masters or Schools attendance, and other academic qualifications.	Up to 3 points
<b>Interview</b>		
During the interview, the Candidate will introduce his/her Research project; the knowledge of the specific legal context related to the proposed Research item will be tested, as well as a critical debate over a specific proposed text. The Candidate's linguistic skills will also be verified.
