| The aforementioned project is not binding concerning the subseque choice of the doctoral thesis, except for positions with a defined theme.* *In the case of applications for scholarships with a specific theme, to coherence of the research project with the theme is a requirement of the evaluation. Therefore, the research project must necessarily relate to the topic of interest, otherwise the candidacy will be excluded. Upon admission to the doctoral program, the candidate will pursue research training and the thesis consistently with the reported theme.
